Spotlight on Grant Recipient: Tom Rubino

Carrying Forward Dr. Charles Tripoli's Legacy of Compassionate Care

The Tripoli Foundation is honored to highlight Tripoli Foundation awardee Thomas Rubino, a medical student at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine, the same medical school Charles Tripoli attended. Tom's career path and personal journey reflect the very ideals that inspired the Foundation's creation — service, education, and a deep commitment to humanity.

Like Dr. Tripoli, Tom's deep-rooted foundation in family values instilled in him a strong sense of purpose and compassion. He also developed a profound understanding of the patient experience, which strengthened his desire to help others. Now in his fourth year of

medical school, Tom has decided to pursue a career in Family Medicine — a field that will allow him to build lasting relationships with patients and serve people of all ages, all characteristics that Charles Tripoli embraced in his medical practice.

And even more fitting to the life experience of Charles Tripoli, who served the poor of Honduras for several years as a medical volunteer, Tom's call to serve the medically vulnerable was further reinforced through his participation in a medical mission to El Negrito, Honduras, with the organization Shoulder to Shoulder, where his team treated more than 100 patients a day in resource-limited conditions. The experience highlighted the versatility and impact of family physicians and solidified Tom's passion for comprehensive, community-based care. Tom's dedication to service and his global perspective echo the values and accomplishments of Dr. Charles Tripoli, who championed compassion for all.

Dr. Charles Tripoli once said, "I may not be remembered as the smartest physician, but I want to be remembered as the most compassionate." Despite that prediction, he is fondly remembered by his patients as having both deep clinical acumen and compassion, as does Tom. As Tom interviews for family medicine residency programs, the Tripoli Foundation celebrates his achievements and looks forward to seeing how his career continues to embody Dr. Tripoli's enduring legacy of compassion and care.

Looking Ahead: A Focus on Fundraising

With the first round of grant awards dispersed, the Tripoli Foundation is turning its focus to the future.
